DEAR MR RISTORI

In response to your letter quoted above, I am pleased to forward below the comments as provided by the competent Bulgarian authorities on the Technical Report as follows:

- on page 24 (p. 6.3.1 Public Exposure Monitoring Laboratory) ISO 17025 should be replaced by ISO 17020 since the NCRRP Public Exposure Monitoring Laboratory has been accredited under the <u>ISO 17020 standard</u> not under the <u>ISO 17025 one</u>;
- on page 26 (p. 6.3.2 Radiation Expertise and Radon Monitoring Laboratory)- The laboratory is equipped with a <u>RADOSYS-system</u> for passive-type radon determinations. In order to determine the volume indoor radon concentration, the laboratory analyses <u>700-1000</u> samples per year not <u>70-100</u> samples per year as indicated in the Report.

Given the typo-nature of our remarks, we would appreciate very much if those comments could be taken into account in the final Technical Report before publishing on the EC webpage.
