



Continous call

Deep renovation **is not** mandatory!






Identified barriers

- "Low-hanging fruits" already done
- Small projects (aggregation required)
- Colateralization problems (housing communities)
- State aid issues
- Lack of Beneficiaries' capacity building and skills
- Lack of contractors
