Budget cuts: no municipal funds for a soft loan.






Investment Bank (EIB).

## Set up a partnership with Parma Energy Agency (ATES Parma):



- 1. Raise awareness (info process);
- 2. Free technical assistance to home owners.

#### Some recommendations



- RESIDENTIAL BUILDINGS: Cities should be allocated resources to invest in one-stop-shops that provide integrated energy efficiency service packages to homeowners.
- REAL INVOLVEMENT OF CITIES: Cities should be better involved by the regions/governments in the definition of needs and preparation of operational programs.



FLEXIBILITY: ESIF should be more flexible so that unspent funds under current priorities could be re-allocated to cities' sustainable energy & climate projects.



GLOBAL SOLUTION: it should be financed integrated projects not only EE investments (e.g. structural works along energy retrofits).
