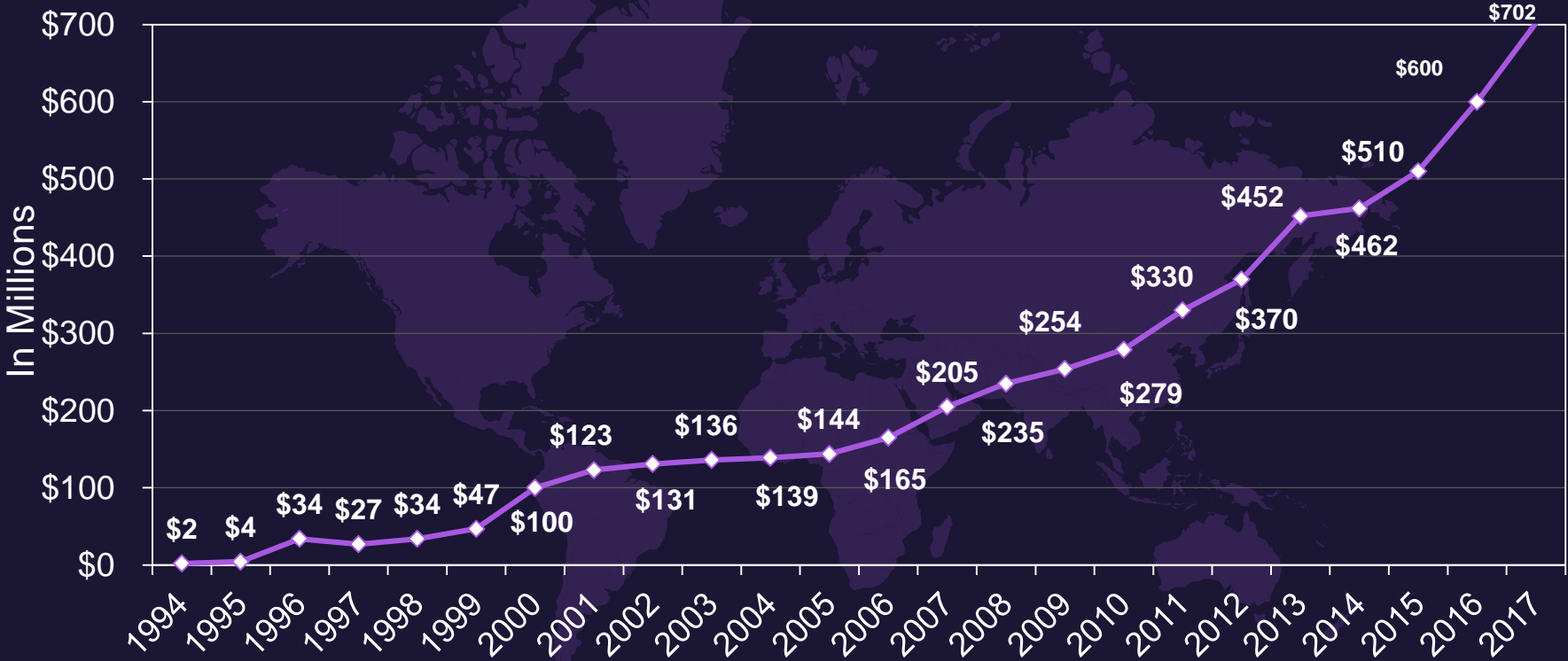

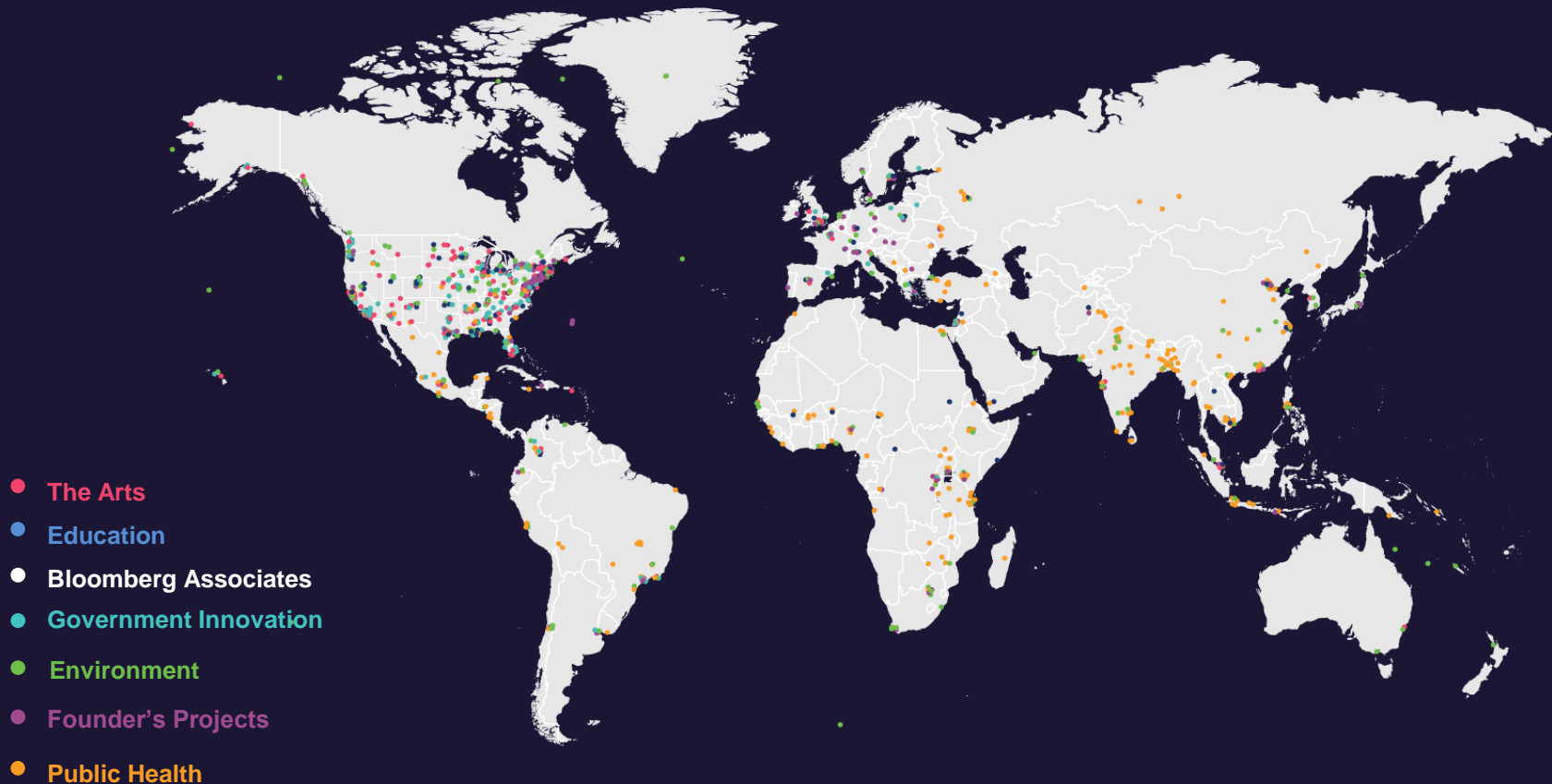

---

Coal-fired power plants account for **1/3 of all U.S. carbon emissions** and **more than \$100 billion** in health costs.

U.S. has retired more than half of its coal fleet in the last six years.
