



Several pathways for a climate neutral Europe, challenging but feasible from technological, economic, environmental and social perspectives







# **Key features of the Innovation Fund**

Volume of at least EUR 10 billion at current carbon prices	Support of up to 60% of additional costs related to innovative technology	First call expected for 2020 and regular calls up to 2030
Financed from the revenues of the EU Emissions Trading System	Support of additional capital <u>and</u> operating costs (up to 10 years)	Comprehensive selection criteria and project development assistance
