Subject: Receipt of the notification on prolonging the validity period for the derogation for a transitory hybrid model operation of the electricity market in Crete

On 18 December 2023, the Commission received an application by the Greek Ministry of Environment and Energy on prolonging the validity period for the derogation with regards to a "transitory hybrid model of the operation of the electricity market in the island of Crete", pursuant to Article 66 of Directive (EU) 2019/944 of 5 June 2019 on common rules for the internal market for electricity and Article 64 of Regulation (EU) 2019/943 of 5 June 2019 on the internal market for electricity. The notified request is available on our website.

According to Article 66 of Directive (EU) 2019/944 and Article 64 of Regulation (EU) 2019/943, the Commission shall decide on whether a derogation can be granted. The Commission invites Member States and all interested parties to provide comments on the derogation request. In order to allow for a timely analysis of the derogation request, the Commission asks for any comments to be provided within 4 weeks from the publication of this document.
