Question 1:

The work programme of Horizon 2020 lists an indicative budget for the establishment of a Buildings Observatory of 1 Mio Euro. In contrast, the tender specifications say that "No maximum budget indication can be provided". Could you provide guidance on the budget available?

Answer 1:

As mentioned in the tender specifications, it is up to the tenderer to submit a financial proposal on the basis of his estimation of the number of man-days needed to perform the requested services. The budget mentioned for each individual action in the Work programme 2014-2015 is indicative. Still budget flexibility rules are set in part 19 "general annexes" to the Work programme:
