Mrs. Tsaltampasi was awarded the title of Ambassador of Women Entrepreneurship in 2010 by the European Commission for her work in promoting women's entrepreneurship. She was also honored in 2014 with the title "Women Motivator in Mediterranean" and in 2018 she received an honorary award, from the Central Union of Municipalities of Greece — K.E.D.E., for her overall contribution to women's entrepreneurship. As president of SEGE and WEnCoop, she has led WEnCoop to win the National and European Award, of the category "Green Transition", in the European Enterprise Promotion Awards - EEPA 2022.
