## 1st report on import controls in the frame of Regulation (EU) 297/2011

8 April 2011

16 countries provided feed back: 14 Member States (SV, CY, BG, FIN, IT, PT, EE, DK, NL, CZ, AT, SK, DE, FR) and Norway (NO) and Switzerland (CH)

Most countries (10) reported to have no analytical results available. Only 6 countries reported analytical results, in total 40 samples:

CZ: 2 samples

AT: 4 samples

DE: 23 samples

FR: 5 samples

SK: 2 samples

CH: 4 samples

In most cases no detectable levels of Iodine-131, Caesium-134 and Caesium-137 were found only in 3 cases a very low level was analysed:

- CZ green tea Cs-137: 1.12 Bq/kg
- SK- tea Cs-137: 1.22 Bq/kg
- DE bamboo germs I-131: 2 Bq/kg

AT analysed also Americum-241 but did not find detectable levels
