

The European Investment Project Portal (EIPP¹) is a brand new web portal enabling EU based project promoters – public or private – to reach potential investors worldwide.

The Portal is provided and hosted by the European Commission and is part of the Investment Plan for Europe initiative to mobilise investment, promote economic growth and create more jobs across the EU.

## WHAT CAN THE PORTAL DO FOR YOU?

- The Portal is designed in response to investors' desire to see more potential EU investment opportunities in a central information platform
- The Portal will boost the visibility of your projects to a large network of international investors, by presenting projects in a structured and harmonised format
- The Portal is in a pre-launch phase and is expected to go live in the Spring of 2016. It will offer advanced search and filtering criteria, as well as the option to freely register and «subscribe» for project updates, making it easy for investors to find projects according to their own preferences

# WILL MY PROJECT BE ELIGIBLE?

To be admitted for publication on the Portal, your project must:

- have a total cost of at least FUR 10 million.
- fall under one of the pre-determined higheconomic-value-added areas (a choice of up to two areas per project is available to the promoters, see overleaf)
- be expected to start within three years of their submission
- be promoted by a public or private legal entity established in an EU Member State
- be compatible with all applicable EU and national laws.

Publication of a project can be denied on legal, reputational or other grounds.

# HOW CAN I REGISTER MY PROJECT?

You can already submit your investment project by simply visiting <a href="http://ec.europa.eu/eipp">http://ec.europa.eu/eipp</a> and following the instructions.

A reduced fee of €100 will be charged to private project promoters once their project submissions are complete. This procedure will apply only during the current pre-launch phase, after which the fee will be increased to up to €250.

Public sector project promoters are exempt from the project submission fee.
