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Reporting requirements as per Article 19(2) of Directive 2009/28/EC on the promotion of the use of energy from renewable sources and amending and subsequently repealing Directives 2001/77/EC and 2003/20/EC

According to Regulation (EC) No 1059/2003 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 26 May 2003 on the establishment of a common classification of territorial units for statistics (NUTS), all the area of Malta is one NUTS level 2. This is further disaggregated in two areas defined as NUTS level 3, the area covering the island of Malta; and the area covering the islands of Gozo and Comino.

Given the scarce arable land available in the Maltese Islands and the limited amount of fresh water resources, the local cultivation of crops for biofuel production is discouraged and even considered as an unfeasible or unsustainable option. Furthermore, the Maltese agricultural authorities uphold that it also compromises local forage production which is important for support to the dairy industry. Normally, Malta is not self-sufficient in fodder crops and it already imports additional forage to supplement its local production. Any further importation would be an added cost which the industry cannot afford.

In view of the above, no study was ever undertaken on the probable greenhouse gas emissions from agricultural products cultivated on Maltese arable land.

The limited quantities of biodiesel which are currently produced locally are sourced from recycled waste cooking oil or imported vegetable oil.
