4th report on import controls in the frame of Regulation (EU) 297/2011

09 May 2011

15 countries provided feed back: 13 Member States (CY, DE, UK, GR, CZ, IRL, FIN, RO, IT, DK, LV, EE and AT) and Norway (NO) and Switzerland (CH)

3 countries reported on previous period (PL, RO and LV)

5 countries reported to have no analytical results available. 9 countries reported analytical results, in total 22 samples (13 products originating from Japan, 9 from fish from Pacific region):

UK: 1 sample

DE: 5 samples

GR: 4 samples

IT: 2 samples

AT: 5 samples

CY: 1sample

DK 1 sample

LV: 2 samples

CH: 1 sample

In nearly all cases no detectable levels of Iodine-131, Caesium-134 and Caesium-137 were found. In one sample of frozen lake trout from Canada a very low level of Caesium-137 was found.
