

The barriers to energy efficiency investment

The lack of standardisation



- Greater performance risk
- Uncertainty limiting demand
 - Higher transaction costs
 - Difficult to build capacity
 - Difficult to aggregate

Investor Confidence Project (ICP) has developed energy performance **Protocols** for developing and documenting projects. Protocols build on **best practice**, national and EU standards.

Project Developers **train** on the ICP Protocols and implement them in **projects**.

THIRD-PARTY VERIFICATION

Quality Assurance Assessors train on the ICP Protocols and **verify** ICP projects meet the ICP standards.

The highest confidence level is applicable to ICP credentialed projects. This contracts the performance parameters and reduces the premium. The exact reduction in premium depends on the nature of the project to start with."
