





### Integrated Projects are designed to:

• (a) to implement plans and strategies for example:

Air Quality Plans, greenhouse gas mitigation strategies, low carbon economy roadmaps or urban action plans pioneering the transition to a low carbon

- (b) at large territorial scales
- (c) with full engagement of all the concerned stakeholders and
- (d) aiming at mobilising significant additional sources of funding to further support the implementation of the ambitious EU environment and climate policy framework.

## LIFE 2019 call for proposals, Climate Change Mitigation (CCM) priority area, relevant policy areas:

Member States' and regional/ local authorities' efforts to reduce greenhouse gas emissions in the sectors <u>not</u> covered in the EU Emissions Trading System but covered by the Effort Sharing Decision (EU) 406/2009 and subsequent legislation: transport and fuels, agriculture, construction (e.g. energy efficiency in buildings), land use, land-use change and forestry;

The development and implementation of greenhouse gas accounting and climate change mitigation in the land use sector;

The development of land management practices which have an impact on emissions and removals of emissions;

Actions which enhance the functioning of the emissions trading system and which have an impact on energy and greenhouse gas intensive industrial production;

Greenhouse gas monitoring and reporting by authorities.



## LIFE 2019 call for proposals, Climate Change Governance and Information (GIC) priority area, targeted policy areas:

The following European policy areas listed below are encouraged (list is non-exhaustive):

- Development and implementation of national 2030 climate and energystrategies and/or mid-century strategies;
- Incentivize behavioral change, mainstream emission reduction and resource efficiency actions in sectors;
- Assessment by authorities of the functioning of the EU ETS

## LIFE 2019 call for proposals, Environment and Resource Efficiency (ENV) priority area, relevant thematic priorities:

Activities for the implementation of the specific objectives for air and emissions in the Roadmap for a Resource-Efficient Europe and the 7th Environment Action Programme, in particular:

- (i) integrated approaches to the implementation of Air quality legislation;
- (ii) facilitate compliance with Union air quality and related air emissions standards including the National Emissions Ceilings Directive 50;
- (iii) enhanced implementation of the Industrial Emissions Directive, with a special emphasis on improving BAT definition and implementation process, ensuring easy public access to information and enhancing the contribution of the IED to innovation.



### LIFE 2019 call for proposals, Environment and Resource Efficiency (ENV) priority area, relevant project topics:

Priority will be therefore given to the following projects (non-exhaustive list):

#### Air quality legislation and the NEC Directive

- Air quality improvement and emission reduction of particulate matter (PM) in areas with high use of solid fuel like biomass, coal, and peat for domestic heating.
- Sustainable road transport mobility aiming at emissions of air pollutants, the reduction of which is essential for helping meet air quality standards

#### **Industrial Emissions Directive**

Application of pollution prevention and abatement techniques referred to in the Industrial Emissions Directive as emerging techniques.

#### **Urban environment**

• Implementation of integrated urban policies and regulatory approaches for sustainable planning and design and/or for supporting innovative technical solutions to improve at least one of the following aspects: urban public transport and mobility, energy or resource efficiency or no-/low-emission renewable energy or materials solutions, local food production and/or the condition of urban ecosystems and their services

## LIFE 2019 call for proposals, Environmental Governance & Information (GIE) priority area, relevant thematic priorities & topics:

Information, communication and awareness raising campaigns

Activities in support of effective control process as well as measures to promote compliance

- Improving environmental information systems operated by public authorities for electronically collecting, processing, storing and sharing environmental information
- Improving the capacity and quality of public administration in relation to plans, programmes, analyses, reviews and assessments and/or to permits, derogations, and other decisions on specific activities

**Supporting environmental compliance assurance** by developing and implementing or implementing existing cross-border, national or regional risk-based strategies to **promote, check and enforce compliance** through use of a mix of administrative law, criminal law and environmental liability
