



Mainstreaming energy efficiency finance

Call H2020-LC-SC3-EE-10-2018-2019-2020

- Frameworks for the standardisation and benchmarking of energy efficiency investments
- Capacity building for banks and investors
- Gathering, processing and disclosing large-scale data on actual financial performance of energy efficiency investments

- Further integration of non-energy benefits in project valuation and adapted financial offer
- Increase share of EE investments in institutional investors' portfolios
- Explore the impact of revised risk ratings and requirements for EE on financial regulations


Deadline (extended): 10 September 2019





EeMAP (Action plan) & EdDaPP (Data protocol)

- Creating a standardised "energy efficient mortgage", for building owners to improve energy efficiency or acquire an already energy efficient property by way of preferential financing linked to the mortgage
- 2 assumptions:



EE leads to a reduction in the impact of energy costs income, reducing borrowers' probability of default

Pilot phase with 45 banks



QualitEE



Quality certification frameworks for energy efficiency services

- Quality certification frameworks for EE services in 8 countries
 - 1) Specification of standardised quality criteria
 - 2) Institutionalisation of quality assurance process
 - 3) Active promotion schemes
- Guidelines on EU-wide standardised "technical quality criteria" and "minimum financial information"

- Common understanding of "good quality" for energy efficiency services
- Better informed investors
- Increased availability of viable finance
- Increased trust and investment in energy efficiency services





Innovative financing for energy efficiency investments

Call H2020-LC-SC3-EE-9-2018-2019

- Set-up new innovative, operational financing schemes
 - e.g. dedicated credit lines, guarantee facilities, on-bill or on-tax financing, etc.
- Replicate previously successful solutions
 - e.g. developed/implemented under various PDA facilities

- Establish regional/national aggregators able to develop large (standardized) project pipelines
- Create EU or regional/national energy efficiency investment roundtables/platforms

Deadline (extended): 10 September 2019





ESI Europe

- > Energy savings insurance mechanism for SMEs
- > Simplified independent validation/verification
- > Standardised contractual arrangements

EuroPACE

- > On-tax financing mechanism for energy renovations
- Linking debt to the property rather than to the owner and collecting debt repayment through property taxes



Key features for a successful proposal

- Adequate analysis of market needs and barriers to overcome
- Clear and detailed concept
 addressing real needs of market
 actors a good idea is not
 enough!
- Engagement of market actors at proposal stage and during the whole duration of the action – in particular financial institutions
- Clear viability of the solution(s) envisaged
