
H2020 Energy Efficency -Breaking market barriers

Supporting the project pipeline at EU and local level De-risking the perception of energy efficiency investments



Next generation with the LIFE 'Clean Energy Transition Programme' (2021-2027)

- Continuation of market uptake actions
- Mission: creating market & regulatory enabling conditions for the clean energy transition
- (Radical) market transformation of the fundamentals will be needed to meet targets
- 2 Multi-Annual Work Programmes: 2021 2024 and 2025-2027
 - MAWP 2021-2024 currently under development





(Wider) Support for the energy transition (2021-2027) (non-exhaustif)

- Direct financing
 - Cohesion funds Policy Objective 2: "a greener, low-carbon Europe".
 - Connecting Europe Facility (CEF)
- Reducing investment risks and supporting investmenst development:
 - InvestEU "Sustainable Infrastructure window".
 - ELENA InvestEU Advisory Hub
- Support for policy implementation and capacity building on energy transition
 - LIFE sub-programme "Clean Energy Transition" (LIFE) (+/- €1bn)
- Support for R&I and technological development
 - Horizon Europe including Climate, Energy and Mobility Cluster
