








#### SILESIAN VOIVODSHIP – ENVIRONMENT AS A CHALLENGE



The European Social Progress Index, developed for the European Commission, places the Silesian Voivodship in 250th out of the 272 territorial units surveyed (the last among the regions of Poland).

The low level of the European index may indicate that future high economic growth will not be able to compensate for the low quality of life, which will exacerbate already existing depopulation and stagnation phenomena.





#### **MAIN**

Changing the economic profile of the region and gradually replacing traditional sectors of the economy, such as mining and metallurgy, with new ventures in more productive, innovative and technologically advanced sectors

#### PROGRAM FOR COAL MINING SECTOR

- Program established by the Government 23rd January 2018
- Program is divided into two sections ie.: diagnostic/analytical part and operational part containing specific objectives and actions
- Main goal of the Program is creating conditions to the construction of a profitable, effective and modern sector of coal mining, based on cooperation, knowledge and innovations, which operating in a friendly and predictable program and legal environment, allows for effective use of resource, social and economic potential to ensure high Energy independence for Poland and supports competitiveness of a National Economy
- To reach the main objective, realisation of 10 specific objectives was planned
- The Minister of Energy is responsible for implementation of the Program
- A mining steering committee will be set up next to the minister of Energy, which will be responsible for the monitoring of the Program
- Development and realisation of the Program for Coal Mining Sector is a part of the Strategy for the responsible development

- project's readiness for implementation
- integrated impact on the regional challenges
- involvement of entities from various levels of public management
- intersectoral cooperation
- compatibility with Program for Silesia and other strategic documents

## SPECIFIC FRAMEWORK CRITERIA FOR SELECTION OF PILOT PROJECTS

### STRATEGIC IMPORTANCE

Compatibility with objectives indicated in SOR, Program for Silesia, SRW, RSI, Program for GWK Sector, other strategies, implementation of goals in the strategic dimension, affecting the directions of strategic development in the long term

#### **LABOUR MARKET**

Workplaces generated for people leaving coalmining sector, around mining and related companies. Launch of new functions for existing jobs. Generating new jobs in the transformation process of post-mining areas

#### **TRANSFORMATION**

Transformation of existing and initiation of new functions, activities, processes on postindustrial areas and degraded city centers

#### INFLUENCE

Impact on economy, environment and social capital, multisectorality of activities, internal and external influence

## SPECIFIC FRAMEWORK CRITERIA FOR SELECTION OF PILOT PROJECTS

#### INNOVATIVENESS

generating of new technologies in the mining around-mining and post-mining sectors, compatibility with regional smart specialization

#### **ENVIRONMENT**

Improvement of air, water and soil quality (including recultivation), environmental awareness, waste prevention and implementing rules of *circular economy* 

#### **QUALITY OF LIFE**

Supply of high quality services, improving services availability, improving mobility of the population, access to high quality cultural and health services, leisure activities

EFFICIENCY IMPROVEMENT AND FINANCIAL ENGINEERING

improvement of the effect-to-effort ratio in the area of: economic, environmental, social, PPP, financial assembly

### SPACIAL INFRASTRUCTURE

revitalization of degraded areas connected with economic elicitation process
