Subject: Notification under Article 7(3) of Directive 2012/27/EU of the

European Parliament and of the Council of 25 October 2012 on energy efficiency, amending Directives 2009/125/EC and 2010/30/EU

and repealing Directives 2004/8/EC and 2006/32/EC

In accordance with the requirement under Article 7(3) of Directive 2012/27/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council of 25 October 2012 on energy efficiency, amending Directives 2009/125/EC and 2010/30/EU and repealing Directives 2004/8/EC and 2006/32/EC (hereinafter: the Directive), we notify the Commission of the exemptions that Slovenia will apply regarding reductions in the amount of energy savings pursuant to Article 7(2) of the Directive.

Slovenia will apply the exemptions referred to in Article 7(2)(a) and (c) of the Directive.

Taking into account the reduction in savings permitted by Article 7(2)(a) of the Directive, the energy efficiency obligation concerning final customers will increase gradually from 1 % in 2014 to 1.5 % in 2020: 1 % (2014 and 2015), 1.25 % (2016 and 2017) and 1.5 % (2018 to 2020).

This means the cumulative savings, as defined in Article 7(1) of the Directive will be reduced by 20.83 %, equivalent to 3 051 GWh.

The exemption permitted by Article 7(2) of the Directive will be applied in a manner that enables suppliers to achieve energy savings in the heat production and distribution sector. This means the savings defined in Article 7(1) of the Directive will be reduced by a maximum of 4 %, equivalent to 586 GWh.

The total reduction in savings permitted by Article 7(2) in accordance with Article 7(3) will not exceed 25 % of the savings referred to in Article 7(1).
