Reporting price discounts on motor fuels	Yes. Once in every quarter oil companies are asked to report their monthly discounts. These discounts are deducted from the consumer price. The consumer prices are the current consumer prices minus the last quarter's average discounts.
Market coverage and data sources	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Five large companies (DCC (former Shell), Circle K (former Statoil Fuel and Retail), Q8, Uno-X/YX, OK) • The sample size represents approx. 95 pct. of total consumption (2017).

Biofuels	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The maximum percentages of biofuel component of motor fuels as defined by law is 10% bioethanol in petrol (however most common is 5 %) and 7% biodiesel in diesel. • There is a reduction in excise duty for petrol and diesel with bioethanol/biodiesel. For petrol and biodiesel with a blend within a specific range (4,8 % +/- 0,2 bioethanol and 6,8 % +/- 0,2 biodiesel) there is a fixed excise duty, e.g., the excise duty for petrol with 4,8 % +/- 0,2 bioethanol is 395,4 øre per liter compared to 402,2 øre per liter for petrol without bioethanol (2012-numbers). For blends outside the ranges mentioned above, the reduction in excise duty is calculated corresponding to the share of the blend, however the reduction is relatively smaller than for specific ranges mentioned above.
